Introduction:

- A. Elisha and his protégé are surrounded by Syrian forces and delivered by God's power - 2Kings 6:8-23
- B. Christians must walk by the same kind of faith, making choices in life to flee immorality and to pursue righteousness - 2Cor. 5:7
 - 1. Our enemy is powerful and crafty - 1Peter 5:8-9
 - 2. However, our God is all-powerful and all-wise - James 4:7; 1John 4:4

I. OPEN MY EYES THAT I MAY SEEK

- A. The power of God:
 - 1. To create all things - Rom. 1:20; Acts 17:26-28
 - 2. To protect and save His people - Ex. 14:13-14; 2Chron. 20:15-24
 - 3. To deliver and vindicate His people - Rom. 8:30-39 Note the terms: Savior - vs. 32; Intercessor - vs. 34; Defender - vs. 38
 - 4. To keep our souls safe in the face of trials - 2Tim. 1:12; 1Peter 1:6-7
- B. The power of truth - Heb. 4:12
 - 1. Truth is an attribute of God, part of His Being - Deut. 32:4; John 17:17
 - 2. Truth is the power that convicts the heart and saves the soul from sin
 - a. John 16:8, 13; Rom. 1:16
 - 3. Truth has the power to protect us - Eph. 6:10, 13-17
 - 4. “The simple step of a courageous individual is not to take part in the lie. One word of truth outweighs the world.” (Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn)
- C. The power of love - 1John 4:17; 1Peter 4:8; Col. 3:14
 - 1. Love has the power to overcome evil - Rom. 12:20-21; Matt. 5:43-45
- D. The power of unity - Eph. 4:1-6; Ecc. 4:9-12
- E. The power of forgiveness - Matt. 18:21-27; Mark 11:25
 - 1. Our spirit of forgiveness toward others must reflect God's forgiveness of us - Eph. 4:32; Matt. 6:12, 14-15
 - 2. Forgiveness has the power to heal offenses, strengthen relationships, and secure the bonds of love in the home and in the church.
 - 3. “When I'm praying for you, I am praying for my own peace of mind. I can only have for myself what I am willing to wish for you.” (Marianne Williamson)
 - 4. Forgiveness has a powerful effect on those who see it - Matt 18:31
